

Texas Election Results November 7, 2023

Voter Turnout

Early voting totals indicated statewide turnout could be lower than the last constitutional amendment election in November 2021 when turnout was just 8.75%. Election Day voting totals increased drastically compared to early voting turnout (7.05%). Almost 2.6 million votes were cast statewide. With more than 17.7 million registered voters, turnout was around 14.66%.
